





What is Enrichment?



Although formal lessons end at 2.30pm, the Academy day does not. Students are able to choose from a fantastic range of after-school Enrichment activities and clubs, both academic and non-academic.

We are incredibly proud that we are running over 50 hours of Enrichment each week. Sessions are typically 2.30pm – 3.30pm, although some go on later than this. All sessions run on weekday afternoons by staff volunteers.
