Why should I study this course?

This course is for those students who want to continue their education through applied learning and who aim to progress to higher education and ultimately to employment in the business sector or would like to start their own enterprise. The course provides lots of opportunities for you to achieve employability skills such as problem solving, intrapersonal and interpersonal skills.

The qualification is equivalent in size to one A Level and aims to provide a coherent Introduction to study of the business sector and carries UCAS points.

The learning programme covers:

- Business environments
- Finance
- Marketing
- Human resources.

This course has been approved by the following professional bodies: CIPD, CIPS and CMI. It has also been given the support of universities which state that the content meets their entry requirements.

Who is suitable to study this course?

What GCSE Qualifications Support the Study of this Course?

How is the Course Assessed?

Unit I - Exploring business - assessed by your teacher.

Unit 3 - Personal and Business finance - external assessment (paper based exam).

Unit 2 - Developing a marketing campaign- externally assessed scenario based assessment completed in computer room (ict - exam). Unit 8 - Recruitment and selection process - assessed by your teacher.

The internal assessments are provided by the exam board and you can achieve a Pass, Merit or Distinction in these units.

The external assessments are provided by the exam board and completed in exam conditions.

- Unit 2 is completed in a computer room where your research is used to answer exam questions during a 3 hour window.
- Unit 3 is completed on paper in normal exam conditions, the exam is 2 hours.
